KAISER - Supportive, but no ingestion in hospital

UCHealth - Can prescribe, but no ingestion in hospital.

Sharp - Sharp HospiceCare does not provide or refer patients to physicians who serve as attending physicians for EOLOA and do not allow ingestion at their 3 in-patient hospice facilities. They might prescribe, if your doctor is "affiliated." Hospital ingestion may be allowed in "unusual and rare circumstances"
